ART IDEAS

WORDS OF ENCOURAGEMENT

A kind note can put everyone in a good mood, especially right now. Write down positive messages for everyone driving or walking by. This can be written on the window itself or a large piece of paper.

FAUX STAINED GLASS

This type of glass can be expensive, but the homemade kind is pretty cheap. Create different shapes with painter's tape, then color some or most of them in with washable markers. The finished result will cast a beautiful reflection on your bedroom, kitchen or family room floors.

3D ART

Ready to break out some yarn, string, glue and scissors? Cut, assemble and hang a piece of art that creates a scene. This can be your favorite Festival event, favorite thing about Louisville, or whatever makes you the happiest whether it's your family, friend or hobby. Or it can be completely abstract! Get creative with it!
