

DIY SPIDER CRAFT

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Large black pom-pom
- Two black pipe cleaners
- Scissors
- White glue
- Googly eyes
- Felt or paper scraps
- String



STEP 1

Start out with a large black pom-pom and two black pipe cleaners.

STEP 2

Cut the pipe cleaners in half so that you have four shorter pieces.

STEP 3

To make the legs, gather the four pipe cleaners and stack them on top of each other, making them parallel. Tie them tightly together in the middle with a short piece of pipe cleaner or string. Move the ends outward so that they fan out.

STEP 4

Bend down each leg at roughly the same point.

STEP 5

Place the spider legs on a flat surface to see if they can stand upright. If a leg is too short or too long, straighten the leg and bend it at a point that makes it the same height as the other legs.

STEP 6

Glue two or more googly eyes on the pom-pom. Spiders can have as many as eight eyes! Cut out a mouth from felt, craft foam, or paper. Glue it below the eyes.

STEP 7

Glue the pom-pom onto the center of the pipe cleaner legs. Let the glue dry before moving your spider.

STEP 8

Attach a string by tying a long piece of yarn or string around the middle of the pipe cleaners in Step 3. You can use it to hang the spider from the ceiling or a windowsill or as a fun pull-along spider.
